

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

We invite abstracts on any of the congress topics (see list of topics under the scientific programme).

- Abstracts must be in English language and must be 250 – 500 words in length. Abstract should be submitted via internet. Visit www.eaarp.or.ke/congress/abstract and follow the instructions to download the template for submission of abstract or prepare your abstract following the outline given below and send to the e-mail address provided.
- Specify the Sub-Thematic (ST) area to which the abstract relates most. At most ONE alternative ST may also be indicated (for planning purposes).
- Abstract should clearly summarise the proposed content of the full paper, including any major scientific findings or conclusions. The acceptance of abstracts will be based on their scientific and technical quality as well as clarity of presentation. Some of the accepted papers will be presented as posters.
- Abstract must be received before the deadline of **31 March 2010**. Please note that submission of abstract does not constitute registration for the congress.

Notification of Acceptance

The first author of accepted abstract paper will be notified of acceptance or rejection of the abstract, and the session to which his/her paper is assigned and whether it is accepted for oral or poster presentation.
