

INTRODUCTION

Regional IRPA congresses have been held twice in Africa: South Africa in 2003; and Egypt in April, 2007. The third African IRPA Regional congress (AFRIRPA2010) will be held in Nairobi, Kenya from 13 to 17 September, 2010 under the theme: ***“Strengthening Radiation Protection Infrastructures in Africa: Towards Establishing Effective and Sustainable Co-operations and Networks”***. AFRIRPA2010 will attract radiation protection professionals; users and manufacturers of radiation technologies; service providers; regulators; governmental, non-governmental and international organizations; and members of the general public.
